JULY

July 6 – Fairfax-Bolinas Road, Bolinas Ridge. Meet at the intersection of Hwy 1 and Fairfax-Bolinas Rd. [Map Link](#)
We'll cut and pull seedy broom from magical woodlands and meadows on this spectacular ridge above Bolinas Lagoon. Come check out the progress at the 5 acre prescribed burn site.

July 13 – Pony Pasture and Dipsea Knoll, Stinson Beach Region. Meet at Dipsea trailhead and Hwy 1 intersection. [Map Link](#)
We'll pull and cut broom and Cotoneaster from diverse woodlands and meadows on this beautiful ridge just south of Stinson Beach.

July 20 – Hawk Camp via Marincello Trail, Marin Headlands. Meet at the TV parking lot. [Map Link](#)
We'll cut and saw away the Portuguese broom and small pines from this ridge top in the Headlands in the city that was never built! Citizen action continues!

July 27 – White Gate and Dipsea Knoll, Bolinas Ridge Region. Meet at the Dipsea trail across from White Gate. [Map Link](#)
Pick your favorite activity! We'll work on native tree watering, seed removal or a big hike out to the coastal bluffs to find and remove the last of the broom from our finest coastal prairies overlooking the ocean.

AUGUST

August 3 – Coyote Ridge, Marin Headlands. Meet at the end of Countyview Rd. [Map Link](#)
We'll rove the beautiful grasslands and forest edges above Tennessee Valley removing large broom, cotoneaster and other invasive plants where great infestations of broom once grew and natives now thrive!

August 10 – Rodeo Valley, Marin Headlands. Meet at the Coastal trailhead at Rodeo Beach. [Map Link](#)
We'll rove the outer coastal bluffs to Wolf Ridge and remove small patches of ice plant, jubata grass and other exotics.

August 17 – Homestead Valley, Mt Tamalpais. Meet at the trailhead gate on Panoramic on the long turnout under the cypress trees. [Map Link](#)
We'll continue to clear some invasive cotoneaster and broom from the finest prairies on this lovely ridge top with panoramic views. We have made great progress in rolling back weed invasions in this spectacular area!

August 24 – Rodeo Valley, Marin Headlands. Meet at the Coastal trailhead at Rodeo Beach. [Map Link](#)

Today we will follow up years of successful Cortaderia control and head for the ridge top to spot and remove the last plants. We will check up on former Helichrysum infestations too.

August 31 – Labor Day Weekend, Enjoy the Holiday!

SEPTEMBER

September 7 – Easkoot Creek, Stinson Beach. Meet at Stinson Beach parking lot. [Map Link](#)

We'll weed at Easkoot Creek before it swells from winter rains beckoning Endangered Coho and Steelhead trout to spawn upstream. If time permits we will also pull broom at the Knoll.

September 14 – Battery Wallace at Point Bonita, Marin Headlands. Meet on the east side of Battery Wallace at the newly renovated picnic area. [Map Link](#)

We'll work in wonderful upland habitat overlooking the Majestic Pacific Ocean! Lots of lovely natives have been grown to restore sandy soils where ice plant has been removed today we will do some more ice plant removal and control veldt grass as well to protect this rich sand dune-like plant community.

September 21 – Marincello Trail, Marin Headlands. Meet at the TV parking lot. [Map Link](#)

We'll cut and saw away the Portuguese broom and small pines from this grand entrance to a city in the Headlands that was never built! Citizen action continues!

September 28 – Tam Fire Site on Coyote Creek, Tam Valley. Meet at Eastwood Park. [Map Link](#)

Help restore 12 acres of a former Eucalyptus grove into a native woodland plant community. We'll rove the slopes to nab big and small broom and eucalyptus trees as well as water our trees and lay mulch for fall plantings.
